An outline of our process to improve and protect your home:

- All moveable objects will be placed a safe distance from your home (patio furniture, etc...)
- Tarps will be placed under roof edges to catch debris and protect grass and plants
- 2" x 6" boards will be nailed to bottom roof edge to protect workers and gutters (steep pitch)
- Once the old roof (shingles, felt, edge metal, etc...) is torn off the entire roof surface will be swept and cleaned of all debris
- Gutters will be cleaned
- Any rotted plywood will be replaced (replacing 1 sheet will be done at no charge, any additional will be replaced at a \$40.00 per man hour plus material basis)
- New edge metal, ice shield, and felt paper will be installed
- New shingles will be installed in accordance with the manufacturer's warranty
- New flashings for all PVC pipes will be installed
- New vents will be installed (if your roof needs additional ventilation or a reduction in ventilation this will be presented in the estimate and discussed with you)
- All exposed nail heads will be caulked
- Gutters will be cleaned a second time
- Large and small magnets will sweep entire ground area around the house to pick up any stray nails
- All objects moved at the beginning of the job will be moved back

Things you should know about getting your roof replaced:

1. **Installing a new roof is a noisy and potentially dangerous process.** We recommend that no one be home during the installation. Installing a new roof creates an enormous amount of noise and is hard on the nerves of pets and makes it hard for small children to take a nap. We take great care in providing a safe work environment for our employees, but you need to be aware of the danger of coming outside a doorway during a roof installation. Workers above are not aware that you may be coming outside. If you are home and need to leave please try to get the attention of a worker through a doorway or window and let them know you need to exit. This will be relayed to everyone in the area and work will be stopped until you are a safe distance from your home.
2. **If you have a satellite dish attached to your roof we will have to remove it to install the new roof.** We will reattach the dish in the same spot but this will often lose your signal. Please call your dish provider and schedule service for a day or two after your new roof is scheduled to be finished. If the signal is good you can cancel the appointment, if not you will already have it set up to be repaired. Allied Exteriors is not responsible for and does not have the equipment to restore a lost signal.
3. **If you have special plants that need extra protection please let us know ahead of time.** If your home has extensive landscaping close to the house we recommend having your roof completed in early spring or late fall.
4. **During the installation do not park or drive any vehicles in your driveway.** The night before work is to begin please park all vehicles you will need in the street. Often stray nails will hit the concrete and bounce further down the driveway. During windy days small pieces of debris may take flight and could scratch a vehicle parked too close to the work area.
